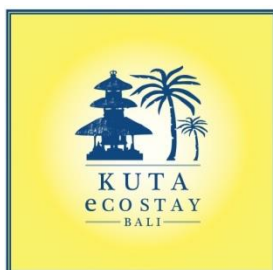
How are we Green?

This is the how:

1. Construction of Kuta EcoStay

- **Double brick walls** – for better insulation and sound proofing
- **Toilets** – bio-septic sewerage system so the effluent is acceptable to recycle into drains with no negative environmental impact. Naturally occurring safe bacteria treat the wastewater through a system of underground tanks and literally eat up the waste leaving grey water that is safe to discharge
- **3 m high ceilings** – for good air circulation and cooler rooms
- **Ceiling fans** – in every room as an alternative to the ACs in each guest room
- **Glass blocks** – built into the walls to give natural light in every guest room
- **Bamboo** – our panorama rooftop bar for guests to use and chill out is made from bamboo
- **Awnings and canopies** – used to allow ventilation through the central atrium which divides the North and South wings which gives shade, fresh air and a feeling of space
- **Roofing** – made from durable water proof roofing sheets with insulation bats underneath
- **Minimalism** - room sizes are sufficient without feeling cramped for two persons with a queen sized double bed in each guest room
- **Green Building Code** - Kuta EcoStay has been constructed based on the Green Building Code for insulation, energy efficiency, water conservation and reusable building materials.

2. Our Operations



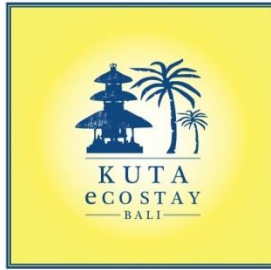
- **Bed linen** – washed by ourselves to avoid harmful chemicals used by the commercial laundries
- **Garbage** – bins strategically located to separate the rubbish into plastic, cans, paper and organic
- **Energy saving** – long lasting low energy light bulbs used
- **Eco-friendly furnishings** - made from plantation grown teak wood
- **Amenities** – ultra modern but not opulent or luxurious, such as our stainless steel rain showers in every WC
- **Outside shower** - when you return to Kuta EcoStay from the beach, shower outside near the fish pond to avoid taking sand into your room and into the bed.

3. Our People

- **Staff training**- trained in the four Rs : reduce, re-use, retain, recycle
- **Eco-policies** – shaped towards sustainability and environmental stewardship to create a sustainable hospitality industry in Bali
- **Ownership** – we the proprietors are a semi-retired couple with an eco-conscience who are concerned that we all need to do more to ensure Bali remains pristine by setting an example, one small step at a time.

4. Our Bali Community

- **Support of the Arts** – we support local talented artists; take a look at the paintings in every guest room
- **Support of Charities** - we support the Gift of Happiness Foundation which brings a smile to children in this region (see their website on our homepage)
- **Balinese entrance** – we face a temple so we want to make sure our entrance and outside wall blend in with the local community
- **Buy Local** – we buy locally made items and produce and employ local people



- **Location** – we are in the heart of Kuta, just 500m to the beach so no need for taxis and other fuel guzzlers.
